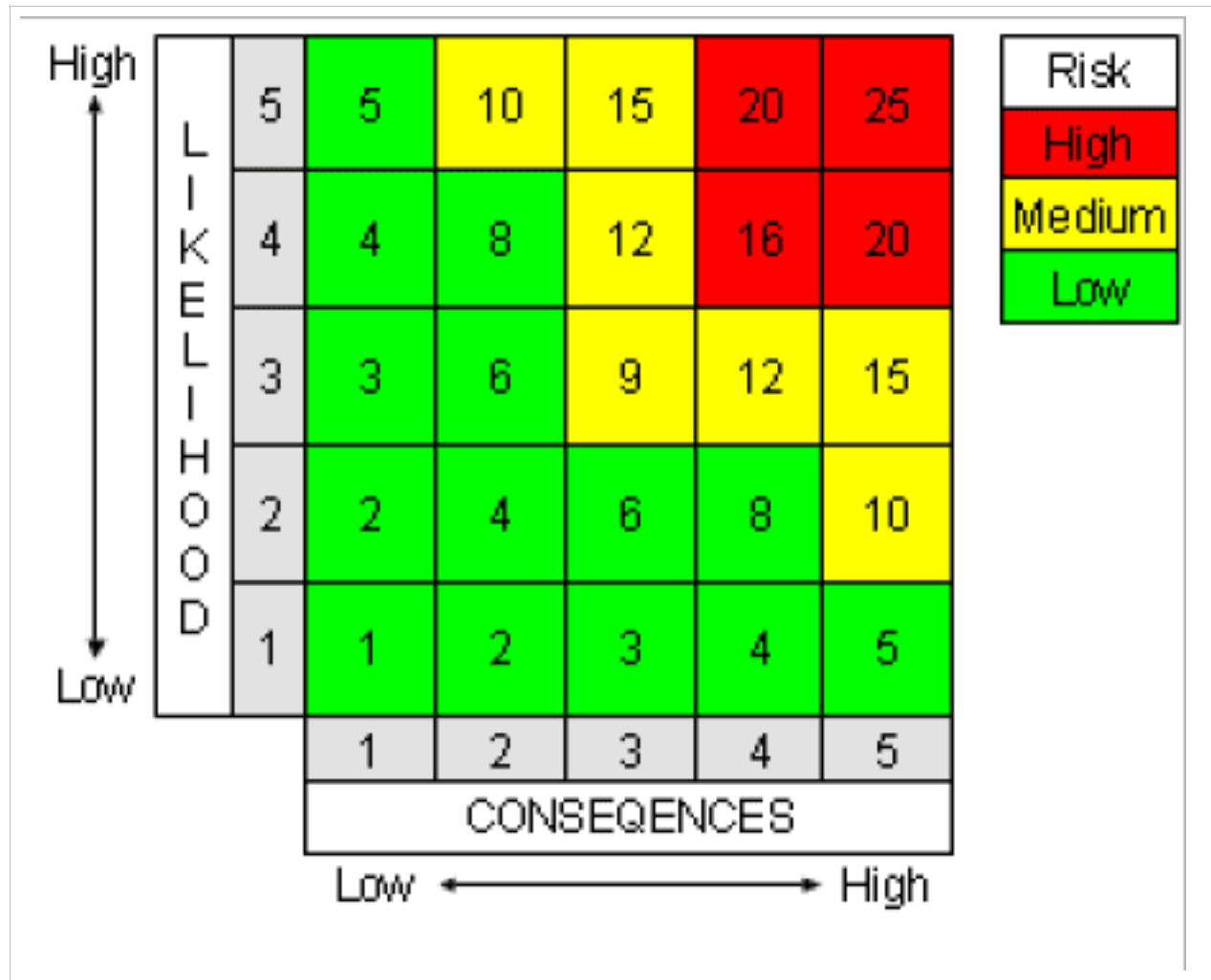

	Carrying Wooden Boss Stands	Trapped Fingers / Splinters. Bruises.	Members shown the best method of carrying stands.	1	2	Low	Regular Equipment Checks & Provide Gloves
	Sharp Tools	Stabs / Cuts	Members shown how to use pegs when securing bosses.	1	5	Low	No Further action
Setting up of Bows	Bows in tension.	Knocks to hands and face,	All Archers instructed in correct method of bow assembly.	2	2	Low	No further action
	Arrows	Stabs	Arrows are contained until shoot signal is given.	2	2	Low	No further action
Shooting	Loosed Arrows	Body Penetration	All Archers trained in safe handling of bow and follow "Shoot" and "Clear" sound signals. No Archer is forward of shoot line during shooting. All Archers vigilant of public and know to call FAST / 4 whistles. Range Control as per AGB requirements in place.	1	5	Low	No further action
