Emergency Procedures when Shooting Outdoors at East Leake Playing Fields Charity

Keyworth Archers uses the facilities at East Leake Playing Fields Charity Cricket, Football and Rugby Ground for outdoor archery through the months April to September. During this period the only Keyworth Archers assets retained on the site are a trailer and the outdoor shooting equipment which is contained in the trailer. The clubs equipment storage trailer is parked a safe distance from the buildings on the same site.

The shooting range, when set up, is adjacent to housing but shoots away from them on to an open field area well away from the buildings on the site.

While there is no barrier to prevent others walking into the shooting area standard Archery GB rules apply to stop the firing of arrows until the danger is removed.

With the above in mind the considered emergencies for Keyworth Archers are:-

- a) Fire
- b) Serious Injury
- c) Access to Defibrillator

Fire

In the event of a fire breaking out in the buildings on site Archers are instructed to remain on the range, which is at a safe distance from the buildings, and remain there until instruction from an authorised person dealing with the fire. If no other party is on the site at the time the fire is started then they should:-

- call 999 giving details of the fire, the address, their name
- request any advice on what they should do or where they should go.

Serious Injury

In the event of a club member or 3rd party sustaining a serious injury they should:-

- - Call 999 requesting medical support giving details of the injury, address, name and contact number.
- - Contact - Janet Worrell (Club Chairperson) 07866 514169 or Rob Anastasi (Membership Secretary) 07950 358546 for next of kin details .
- - Contact next of kin informing of the situation and if appropriate to which hospital the injured person has been despatched.
- **Access to Defibrillator**
Currently it is not known whether a defibrillator is available at this venue.

Fire

In the event of a fire in:-

a) The East Lake Playing Fields buildings, members are advised to remain on the range until instructed to leave by someone in authority dealing with the fire,

Note: If no members of the affected buildings are present 999 should be called.

Serious Injury

In the event of a club member or 3rd party sustaining a serious injury they should:-

- Call 999 requesting medical support giving details of the injury, address, name and contact number.

- Contact next of kin informing of the situation and if appropriate to which hospital the injured person has been detached.
